Learning New Music – even now!

- listen and loo along with music, watching sheet music – no singing
- sing along with music (watching sheet music)
- pantomime with CD (NO sheet music)
- sing with CD (NO sheet music)

Remember this?

HINT LIST

1. Put your arms out as if you were going to pick up a chair
Now keep your chest cavity that way when you sing
2. Oo-r (oo as in moon) Pucker up!
When singing a word like “range”, sing it as “oo-range” and it will come out right.
3. Ooh- for wh
When becomes ooh-en.
4. Replace deer with dee-eh
(Notice how your mouth gets l ongways up and down rather than sideways?)
Replace word with w-eh-d (pucker with the -eh-)
Replace heard with h-eh-d
5. Bubble – again pucker up

Singing notes from Steve

Four Points Answer:

Four things to recall every time you sing (even at home)

- 1). Sing with your mouth in a vertical shape, not horizontal.
- 2). Sing with your cheekbones and eyes(brows) lifted up.
- 3). Sing with good air support. (“Belly Breath”)
- 4). Sing with warm air. (Check the warm air with your hand.)

Let them become second nature. . . Remember?
