WOW! – FANTASTIC rehearsal Monday night! We continue to make amazing progress in preparation for the show. I know I have said this every year for the past 3 years, but this is going to be our 'BEST SHOW EVER'.

Chuck Fish and myself met with the Convention Center Staff this past week for setup requirements preparation in the show. We decided to use the round steps in the front of the stage. This will give us more stage room, and some 'built-in' risers for middle school choirs. We are using chair set-up for 1,250 seats, MINUS the seats taken up by the added stage/steps. (100?) so a net of 1,100-1,150 chairs.

There will be a board meeting next Monday night at 5:30. If everyone in The 'Anything' octet could be there, ready to sing at 6:30, we could get In a quick rehearsal with the octet.

Guys in octet, let me know asap if August 12th, (Tuesday) would be OK for us to carpool to TOTR rehearsal. We would need to leave Hot Springs no later than 4:45? Harrington- Robertson-Campbell-Weston-Fish-Hannah-Hampton-Sands.

SELL – SELL – SELL tickets and sponsorships now !!!!!! We can't wait or delay the process, let's get it cranking. Several have asked about other retirement centers, senior groups, churches, etc. about discount tickets for show. We can make that special available to any senior group, but here are the parameters...

They must commit to promoting it within their group. They must sell tickets within their group- NO individual senior discounts.

...Only as a group (we want one transaction for total ticket sales for each group)

They must provide or make arrangements for their transportation to the show

As a group, we will try to seat them together. (we need wheelchair/disability info for seating)

We would like for them to sell at least 15 tickets within their group.

(tickets are \$7.50 for senior groups, partly underwritten by our AAC Grant)
